What is HRM?

HRM is an [eHealth solution](#) that enables clinicians using a Specification 4.1A funding eligible EMR to securely receive patient reports electronically from participating sending facilities.

HRM electronically delivers text-based Medical Record reports, (e.g. Discharge Summary), and transcribed Diagnostic Imaging (excluding image) reports from sending facilities directly into patients' chart, within the clinician's EMR.

- HRM is now sending e-Notifications about admissions and discharges from Toronto East General Hospital's Emergency Department and inpatient units through the Ontario Association of Community Care Access Centres' (OACCAC) CHRIS system directly to physician EMRs
- HRM is now live with 52 Ontario sending facilities
- OntarioMD is working with EMR vendors to connect 3,000 clinicians who are enrolled in HRM, and continues to enrol new clinicians
- As of November 2014, approximately 1,300 clinicians are using HRM and over 95,000 clinical reports per month are being sent directly into clinician EMRs

Who can get HRM?

If you use Specification 4.1A of a funding eligible EMR from OntarioMD and are in LHINs 1 (Erie St. Clair), 2 (South West), 3 (Waterloo Wellington), 4 (Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant) 5 (Central West), 6 (Mississauga Halton), 7 (Toronto Central), 8 (Central), 9 (Central East), 10 (South East), 11 (Champlain) or 12 (North Simcoe Muskoka), you can connect to HRM.

When can I get HRM?

HRM is available to clinicians whose EMRs are at EMR Specification 4.1A. If you are using a Specification 4.1A EMR, you are ready for HRM. Please contact OntarioMD at report.manager@ontariomd.com to schedule a meeting to sign the required Subscription and User Agreements and start the connection process.

More sending facilities in LHINs 1 to 12 will be added to HRM over the next year. Even if your sending facility is not using HRM yet, it is a good idea to get your practice ready to start receiving reports through HRM as soon as your sending facility goes live.

What do I have to do to get HRM?

1. If you use a Specification 4.1 (or higher) funding eligible EMR from OntarioMD and are in LHIN 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12, contact OntarioMD at report.manager@ontariomd.com
2. Your OntarioMD Practice Advisor will schedule a meeting with you at which time you will review the HRM Welcome Package.
3. Review the Welcome Package for HRM with the OntarioMD Practice Advisor; you may also wish to have your EMR vendor attend the meeting.
4. Sign the Subscription Agreement and a User Agreement for each clinician who will be using HRM.
5. OntarioMD will then work with you and your vendor to connect to HRM.
